

Deadline: April 3, 2023

Eligibility Requirements

- * Be a citizen of the U.S. and reside in San Patricio County. Be a graduating senior in the 2022-2023 school year.
- * Be ranked in the top third (1/3) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year. Ranking is to be verified on official transcript.
- Have made formal application to enroll or be planning to enroll with intent to attend an accredited, not-for-profit Texas college or university (accredited by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges). Must intend to attend school in the 2023-2024 school year.
- Technical Scholarships Only: Be ranked in the top (1/2) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year.
- One letter of recommendation (from employers, teachers, school administrators, or volunteer community or school activity coordinator - must be from someone other than family).
- * A resume of applicants' activities from his/her high school years (school & community related clubs, activities, achievements, employment, etc.)
- * **<u>NEW</u>**: The essay section of the application <u>**Must be typed!**</u>
- * San Patricio County Area Go Texan Committee has the right to refuse and/or retract any scholarship application or scholarship awards during judging, awarding or post awarding process.
- * All applications **MUST** be mailed. No exceptions. Please send everything in one envelope postmarked on or before April 3, 2023 to San Patricio County Area Go Texan Scholarship Committee, PO Box 633, Sinton, TX 78387.
- * Incomplete or late applications will <u>not</u> be accepted! There are <u>no</u> changes to submitted applications.

The Texas 4–H Youth Development Program will once again host 4–H Day at the Capitol on Wednesday, March 29, 2023. This event is designed as a citizenship experience for 4–H members of all ages to learn more about the state legislative process, as well as meet their state representative and senator through an office visit.

Since this event is held during the legislative session and other organizations/groups are at the Capitol on the same day, the number of participants (youth and adults) must be limited.

Other facts about the day that you should consider before registering:

- This event does occur during the legislative session, therefore, the event schedule may change from what is
 published and even distributed the day of the event. Changes to the overall schedule as well as House and Senate
 member visits will be occurring throughout the day and the 4-H Program will do our best to maintain the most
 up-to-date schedule changes through email and text messaging.
- We request patience of all our 4–H members, parents, and County Extension Agents during the event due to the fast pace of the event. This includes not just schedule changes, but cancellation of office visits or locations of visits.
- For those parents who do not get registered for the event, but their 4-H member did, they are welcome to attend and join in on the gallery and office visits, but due to space, the welcome assembly in the auditorium and the lunch will be limited to only registered individuals. The Capitol does have a cafeteria located close to the room where the event lunch will be served.
- 4-H members attending the event maybe separated from their parents for periods of time when they are in the welcoming assembly or on office visits, please be assured it is the priority of the 4-H Program that each youth member is safe and comfortable in their participation of the event at all times.
- Each registered participant will receive a t-shirt, therefore the dress is casual-nice (blue jeans or khaki pants/skirt, casual closed toed shoes). The t-shirt will be distributed at check-in and youth will have time to change prior to the event starting.
- A detailed information packet will be sent to each registered participant approximately a week before the event with an updated schedule, parking information and other logistical information.

If your animal loses its validation tag, call the Extension Office ASAP with the tag number so that a replacement can be ordered.




To be eligible to compete in the A&H Show in any division, (including Homemaking) you must attend at least 60% of club meetings. Attendance for the 2023 Show starts in January, 2022. You must also meet **UIL academic eligibility requirements** by passing all of your classes. Start out the 4-H year right by attending club meetings and

keeping your grades up!

<u>New 4-H members</u> must also attend 60% of their club meeting, however, their club attendance begins on Sept. 1, 2022. Only new 4-H members will be allowed to count January 2023 attendance.

ADULT VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECK

To protect our 4-H members, the Texas 4-H Program administers an adult screening program. This screening is conducted every 3 years. All adults who will be working directly with youth (other than their own children) must complete the adult registration form on 4-H Online to be screened. Once their registration has been approved from the State office, then we can certify those adults as San Patricio County volunteers. Only those adults who have been screened and cleared through YPS will have the privilege of working with 4-H members. There is a \$10 annual fee for each adult who will be a Volunteer. This fee is paid on 4-H Online.
