#### Texas 4-H Horse Validation

2023 Texas 4-H Horse Validation Process opens on <u>March 1, 2023</u> on 4-H Online and will run through <u>April 15, 2023</u> at a cost of \$10 per horse. From <u>April 16, 2023</u> to <u>May 1, 2023</u> the cost increases to \$20 per horse. All horses must be validated or re-validated with payment each year, to be eligible to show at District and State 4-H Horse Shows. Horses validated last year on 4-H Online, you will need to re-

activate on 4-H Online and pay for validation. Each validation must include front, right side, and left side view images. The entire horse should be included in the photo and markings should be clearly visible. If the horse is registered, a copy of the registration papers must be uploaded. These papers must list the 4-Her, parent, sibling, grandparent or legal guardian as the current owner. If the ownership is in the process of being transferred, please list "pending" in the registration number area. <u>Uploads must be images</u>.

\*NEW IN 2023\* : Lease horses are now eligible to be validated and shown at District and State 4-H Horse Shows. An official Texas 4-H Horse Lease Agreement must be signed by the exhibitor, horse owner, and the supervising County Extension Agent. The lease period must include, at minimum, May 1st to August 31st of the current 4-H year. The lease agreement form can be found at https://texasyouthlivestock.com/horse-validation/ and must be uploaded to 4-H Online at the time of validation.

The State Fair of Texas is requiring validation for registered breeding sheep, registered breeding goats, wether/ commercial dams, and wether/commercial does.




**\*NEW FOR 2023\*** Lambs & goats validated during the 2023 State Fair Validation Period **WILL BE ELIGIBLE** for **2024 Spring Major Shows**. Market animals validated for the 2023 State Fair will carryover for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Once validated, the project **MUST** stay in the care of the exhibitor that project is validated to; if the exhibitor chooses to sell the project to a new exhibitor, the new exhibitor **MUST REVALIDATE** the project within the next validation period.

**Reminders:** In 2021, Texas Lamb & Goat Validation announced the introduction of the **Roll-over Breeding Sheep & Breeding Goat Program**.

 Any Breeding animal validated during the Fall 2021 validation period is eligible to be exhibited by that exhibitor through the Fall 2024 show season. <u>IF OWNERSHIP CHANGES, THEN THE ANIMAL</u> MUST BE RE-VALIDATED.



**\*\* NEW FOR 2023\*\***: All State validated heifers will be tagged similar to steers. This will bring our heifer validation program in line with breeding sheep, breeding goats, and breeding gilts. This is a change from the heifer UINs. This will allow our state validated livestock to move in compliance with TAHC across state lines and be in compliance when issues a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health papers).

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- \* Be a citizen of the U.S. and reside in San Patricio County. Be a graduating senior in the 2022-2023 school year.
- \* Be ranked in the top third (1/3) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year. Ranking is to be verified on official transcript.
- \* Have made formal application to enroll or be planning to enroll with intent to attend an accredited, not-for-profit Texas college or university (accredited by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges). Must intend to attend school in the 2023-2024 school year.
- \* **Technical Scholarships Only**: Be ranked in the top (1/2) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year.
- \* One letter of recommendation (from employers, teachers, school administrators, or volunteer community or school activity coordinator must be from someone other than family).
- \* A resume of applicants' activities from his/her high school years (school & community related clubs, activities, achievements, employment, etc.)
- \* **<u>NEW</u>**: The essay section of the application <u>**Must be typed!**</u>
- San Patricio County Area Go Texan Committee has the right to refuse and/or retract any scholarship application or scholarship awards during judging, awarding or post awarding process.
- All applications <u>MUST</u> be mailed. No exceptions. Please send everything in one envelope postmarked on or before April 3, 2023 to San Patricio County Area Go Texan Scholarship Committee, PO Box 633, Sinton, TX 78387.
- \* Incomplete or late applications will <u>not</u> be accepted! There are <u>no</u> changes to submitted applications.

- 2. An essay from the applicant telling about him / herself which includes wishes, dreams, ambitions, and future educational goals. **Not to exceed 300 words.** Two (2) letters of recommendation (not from a family member).

#### Application, Deadlines & Announcement of Winners

- 1. Applications must be received no later than April 20, 2023.
- 2. Amount & number of scholarships may vary depending on number of applicants.
- 3. Scholarship award notice will be sent to the High School Counselor and / or 4-H / FFA Chapter advisor in May 2023.

For this essay, a 4-H student should discuss why beeswax is so important to the hive (it's a pantry, it's a nursery, it's the dance floor), but also discuss their favorite way to use beeswax outside the hive. Photos of candles, soaps, or lip balms that are made to show the 4-H'er's skill in using beeswax are welcomed as are recipes or brief instructions. Winners will be announced the week of April 24th.

If your animal loses its validation tag, call the Extension Office ASAP with the tag number so that a replacement can be ordered.




To be eligible to compete in the A&H Show in any division, (including Homemaking) you must attend at least 60% of club meetings. Attendance for the 2023 Show starts in January, 2022. You must also meet **UIL academic eligibility requirements** by passing all of your classes. Start out the 4-H year right by attending club meetings and

keeping your grades up!

<u>New 4-H members</u> must also attend 60% of their club meeting, however, their club attendance begins on Sept. 1, 2022. Only new 4-H members will be allowed to count January 2023 attendance.



#### ADULT VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECK

To protect our 4-H members, the Texas 4-H Program administers an adult screening program. This screening is conducted every 3 years. All adults who will be working directly with youth (other than their own children) must complete the adult registration form on 4-H Online to be screened. Once their registration has been approved from the State office, then we can certify those adults as San Patricio County volunteers. Only those adults who have been screened and cleared through YPS will have the privilege of working with 4-H members. There is a \$10 annual fee for each adult who will be a Volunteer. This fee is paid on 4-H Online.
