
# San Patricio County Area Go Texan Scholarship

#### Deadline: April 1, 2024

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- \* Be a citizen of the U.S. and reside in San Patricio County. Be a graduating senior in the 2023-2024 school year.
- Be ranked in the top third (1/3) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year. Ranking is to be verified on official transcript.
- Have made formal application to enroll or be planning to enroll with intent to attend an accredited, not-for-profit Texas college or university (accredited by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges). Must intend to attend school in the 2024-2025 school year.
- \* **<u>Technical Scholarships Only</u>**: Be ranked in the top (1/2) of the graduating class at the completion of the first semester of the senior year.
- \* One letter of recommendation (from employers, teachers, school administrators, or volunteer community or school activity coordinator must be from someone other than family).
- \* A resume of applicants' activities from his/her high school years (school & community related clubs, activities, achievements, employment, etc.)
- \* **<u>NEW</u>**: The essay section of the application <u>Must be typed!</u>
- \* San Patricio County Area Go Texan Committee has the right to refuse and/or retract any scholarship application or scholarship awards during judging, awarding or post awarding process.
- All applications <u>MUST</u> be mailed. <u>No exceptions</u>. Please send everything in one envelope postmarked on or before <u>April 1</u>, <u>2024</u> to San Patricio County Area Go Texan Scholarship Committee, PO Box 633, Sinton, TX 78387.
- \* Incomplete or late applications will **<u>not</u>** be accepted! There are <u>**no</u>** changes to submitted applications.</u>

Is your 4-H member a talented performer? We are seeking youth to sing the National Anthem at Roundup assemblies. Senior level 4-H youth are eligible to apply now through March 1st via <u>4HOnline by selecting the "2024 Texas</u> <u>4-H Roundup - National Anthem Audition" event.</u> All submissions must also be uploaded to YouTube as an unlisted link. YouTube Video must be of the individual or group (up to four 4-H members) singing the National Anthem. Singing must be in acapella style (no music). If submitting as a group, only one member of the group needs to register on 4HOnline and then list the other team members. All members MUST BE ENROLLED in 4-H. Three individuals/teams will be selected to perform, one at each assembly held on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (June 4-6, 2024). Individuals/teams will be announced April 1, 2024. 4-H member does not have to be a contest participant of Texas 4-H Roundup but must register for the event.

# **Reminder:**

If your animal loses its validation tag, call the Extension Office ASAP with the tag number so that a replacement can be ordered.



To be eligible to compete in the A&H Show in any division, (including Homemaking) you must attend at least 60% of club meetings. Attendance for the 2024 Show starts in January, 2023. You must also meet **UIL academic eligibility requirements** by passing all of your classes. Start out the 4-H year right by attending club meetings and

keeping your grades up!

<u>New 4-H members</u> must also attend 60% of their club meeting, however, their club attendance begins on Sept. 1, 2023. Only new 4-H members will be allowed to count January 2024 attendance.

# ADULT VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECK

To protect our 4-H members, the Texas 4-H Program administers an adult screening program. This screening is conducted every 3 years. All adults who will be working directly with youth (other than their own children) must complete the adult registration form on 4-H Online to be screened. Once their registration has been approved from the State office, then we can certify those adults as San Patricio County volunteers. Only those adults who have been screened and cleared through YPS will have the privilege of working with 4-H members. There is a \$10 annual fee for each adult who will be a Volunteer. This fee is paid on 4-H Online.
